VMC was mainly focused on consultation of patients treated within Operational Research (mSTR, BPaL).

The rebranding aligns with a broader focus to TB patients treated within routine practice.

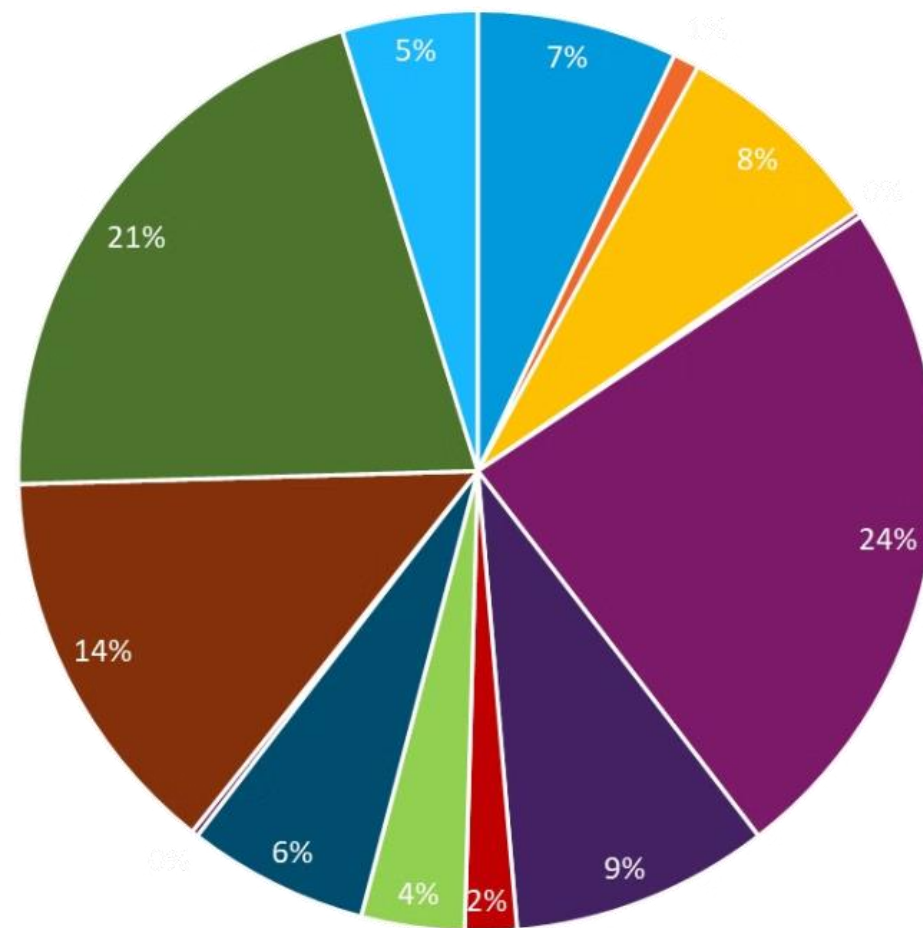
